Courses that can be completed through High School of Business:

- BUS 8500 – Introduction to High School of Business (1- credit)
- BUS 8501 – High School of Business (3-credits)
- BUS 1850 – Introduction to Business (3-credits)

In order to qualify for the college credit, you must:

- Graduate from a high school participating in the High School of Business curriculum recognized and approved by the Department of Education or equivalent.
- Complete the [MSU Denver undergraduate application](#) and satisfy admission requirements for the university.
- Provide the MSU Denver Office of Admissions with:
 - Official high school transcript which included all applicable MBA High School of Business courses completed, and
 - a copy of your MBA High School of Business Certificate of Completion.
