

College Credit Opportunities for High School of Business™ Students at Bowling Green State University (amended for 2021 high school graduates)

High School of Business™ students nationwide have the opportunity to earn up to six college credits from Bowling Green State University in Bowling Green, Ohio. Credit is available for the following courses:

- BA 1500—Overview of Business Administration (3 credits hours)
- ECON 2000—Introduction to Economics (3 credit hours)

Procedure:

- Complete all six required courses¹ in the High School of Business™ sequence
- Apply to BGSU. Be sure to check the “High School of Business™” box on the supplemental information form.
- Be accepted to and enroll at BGSU
- Gain admission into BGSU’s Schmidthorst College of Business
- Authorize MBA Research to confirm completion of six required courses¹ in the High School of Business™ sequence²
- BGSU will contact the student regarding administering an examination to receive credit.
- BGSU will administer a transcription fee⁴ for each course transcribed to student in mid-fall of his/her first semester at BGSU⁶.

Special Notes:

- High School of Business™ students are encouraged to apply for BGSU’s Schmidthorst College of Business scholarships
- Prospective BGSU students are encouraged to contact the Schmidthorst College of Business⁵ to be added to database to receive direct communication.
